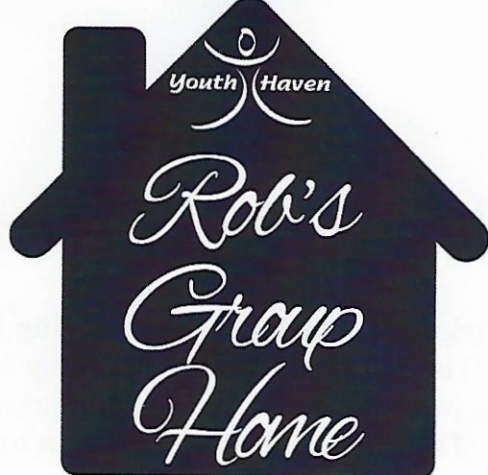

Rob's Group Home

The Homeless Teen & Transitional Living Program (HTTLP) is the first of its kind in Collier County, supporting youth who are experiencing homelessness and in need of assistance in their transition to adulthood. The program provides intensive case management with a strengths-based approach that meets teens' individual needs and encourages them to set and pursue their own goals. The program addresses the various developmental, educational, emotional, social, physical, and mental health needs of homeless youth in our community.
